

Message from the Chairman

As Chairman of the Board of Directors, I am a witness to the work done by the QSF, which participates actively in the evolution of the sport of target shooting. The projects never stop!

We have seen an increase in our membership and over the past four years we have trained over 35,000 people in the CRFSC and over 31,000 people in Bill 9. The figures are more than satisfactory.

I am proud of the growing role that the Federation plays and of their continuously renewed efforts, both at the technological level and at the sport development level.

We are introducing new systems and are working to make our sport better understood by the general public, something which a few years ago would have been unimaginable.

We contribute financial resources to help the Quebec shooting team distinguish itself and to develop future members.

We have also implemented a significant change in authorizing IPSC shooting while moving forward, which has been prohibited in Quebec since 1994.

In addition, we have submitted our brief and testified before the Parliamentary Commission on Bill 64 to express our opposition to the establishment of this registry, which would require significant investments by a number of Quebec's service-based sectors.

We are also directing our efforts toward building the technological resources already in use by several shooting clubs; interactive website for training, member services and competitions, etc.

We will continue to demonstrate our motivation again this year.

IPSC shooting safety rules

Outaouais Shooting Club
25m firing range (Range B)

In general, the safety rules laid out in document(s) (x) published by the International Practical Shooting Confederation (IPSC). However:

1. The only movement authorized with a loaded firearm:

- May take place only in the designated firing area;
- May be performed laterally and in a forward direction.

2. When moving with a loaded firearm, the shooter must:

- Point his/her weapon to fire downrange;
- Not have his/her finger engaged in the firearm's trigger guard.

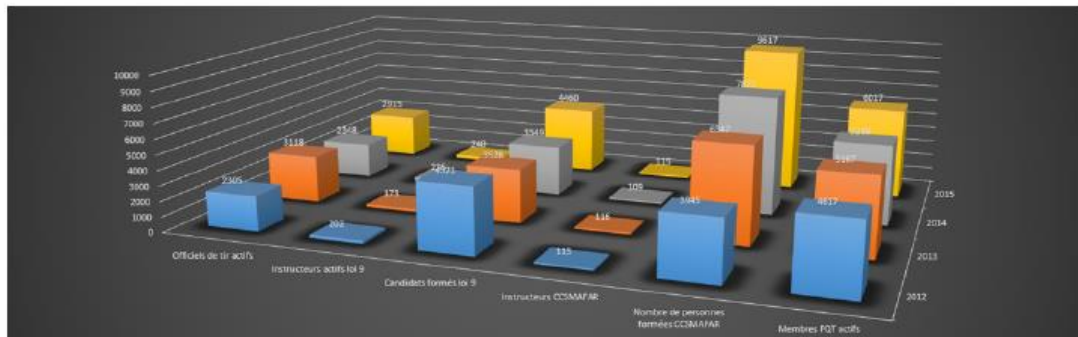
