ARTICLE 1

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL DISCIPLINES

1.1 Registration

REGISTRATION WILL BE BASED ON FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED AND NO REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL AT TIME OF REGISTRATION.

In order to register you must hold a Shooting Federation of Canada membership and you must be logged in to the website.

You must pay by using the online system. If you are unable to pay via credit card please contact Admin@sfc-ftc.ca for other options. Payment must be received before your registration and squadding can be confirmed.

Registration and payment must be received by May 31, 2023 or you will not be able to participate.

1.2 Location of Ranges

The 2023 High Performance Team Trials will be held in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan at the Saskatoon Wildlife Federation's indoor and outdoor range locations.

Outdoor Range – Aberdeen No. 373, SK, S0K 3W0 ([link](#))

The indoor range is located 20min from the Saskatoon Airport and the outdoor range is located 35min from the Saskatoon Airport. There are no shuttles offered

1.3 Shooting Facilities

The Outdoor Range has 15 covered rifle/pistol positions at either 25 or 50 meters and the space can also be safely divided between the two distances. The Air rifle/pistol Range has 30 positions. All targets are Megalink Electronic system.

Parking at the range is very plentiful. The Facilities are fully wheelchair accessible. The outdoor range is 20 min away from the indoor range. All food venues are off the facility.

Range Equipment – Please bring all your own equipment including, shooting mat, scope stand, extensions, stapler, stool or chair, in other words, EVERYTHING. If you do not wish to bring your own mat, the STSA mats will be available.

1.4 Accommodations

The indoor and outdoor ranges are roughly 20 and 35 minutes from Saskatoon Airport respectively and participants will be responsible for making their own bookings for accommodations for this event.

1.5 Transportation

Participants are responsible for arranging all of their own transportation from and to the Saskatoon Wildlife Federation ranges and their own accommodations. Rental cars are available at the **Saskatoon (John Diefenbaker) International Airport**, Saskatoon, SK from:

1.6 Food

Participants are responsible for arranging all of their own snacks and meals. There are many restaurants and fast food services within a 15 minute drive of the indoor range.

1.7 SFC Membership

All competitors must be current members of the Shooting Federation of Canada and will be verified by the SFC National Office during registration.

1.8 SFC High Performance Athlete Selection Criteria

To be eligible for the 2024 SFC High Performance Programs you must attend the 2023 High Performance Team Trials and 2023 Canadian National Championships. Please see the SFC website for current information relevant to High Performance Athletes under Selection Criteria [here](#).

Attendance at High Performance Team Trials is mandatory for High Performance

Program consideration.

High Performance Team Trials is a qualifying score eligible match for those not currently on the 2023 High Performance Team. It is also a qualifying match if you shoot a second discipline and are currently on the 2023 High Performance Team (ex. you are on the current High Performance team for 10m Air Rifle but not 3 Position Rifle, you can shoot qualifying scores at High Performance Team Trials for 3 Position).

If you would like 2023 High Performance Team Trials to count as a qualifying score match you must submit a QSDR [form](#) to the High Performance [portal](#) by **May 31, 2023**. On the form you must specify whether the first course of fire, second course of fire, or both will count as a qualifying score. If you do not specify on the form it will be assumed only the first course of fire will count.

1.9 Major Games Selection

High Performance Team Trials is a selection event for the 2023 Pan Am Games. The best 3 of your 4 scores between High Performance Team Trials and 2023 National Championships will be put into the Pan Am Games Percentage Ranking [List](#) and the top ranked athletes who meet the remainder of the criteria will be selected to the Pan Am Games Team where a quota is available. For full details please consult the Major Games Criteria found [here](#).

High Performance Team Trials is also a selection event for the 2023 World Championships. 2023 High Performance Team athletes will be ranked based on their results at HPTT and will be allowed to attend World Championships in that order.

2024 Pan Am Championships (also known as the 2024 CAT Championships) teams will be selected using 2023 Nationals results only.

1.10 Rules

The most current published ISSF rules including subsequent amendments, interpretations and errata from the ISSF website will apply to all ISSF events in all disciplines unless otherwise noted in this program and/or a change is deemed necessary due to range conditions, such as a current software update is not available for the electronic targets, in which case the revised and/or modified rules that will be

followed will be posted prior to the match. Finals will not be run. It is the responsibility of the athlete and coaches to be familiar with the current ISSF rules which can be found on the ISSF website here:

1.11 Rules and Regulations

Should for any reason the ISSF rules not be followed, the Jury will post the changes on the range bulletin board.

Juries (Equipment Control, Classification and Appeals) are designated by the organizing committee to supervise the 2023 High Performance Team Trials. Qualified Range Officers holding applicable licenses will conduct the competitions.

Regarding the use of only air or CO2 cylinders please refer to ISSF Rule 6.2.4.2. of the rule book which states the following:

“It is the athletes responsibility that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.”

Protests will be handled by the Jury. Cost is \$25.00 each.

The Jury’s decisions are **final**.

1.12 Match Start Times

Please note that the times on the schedule are the times for the first SCORING shot in ISSF events. Preparation and sighting time will commence, in most cases but not all, at least 15 minutes earlier than the published start time as noted in the event descriptions. Please note timings as specified in this program.

As with all events, circumstances may cause delays. Event’s will not start earlier than the time posted but may start later so please be prepared at the scheduled time.

1.13 Special Notice from Match Committee

In the event that a competitor's fired shots hit the electronic scoring target protection plate, the following penalty sequence shall be followed:

First Occurrence: Yellow Card...Warning

Second Occurrence: Green Card...2 point penalty

Third Occurrence: Red Card...disqualification due to unsafe shooting practices.

The score that has been fired for record will be entered into the record sheets. No refund will be offered to the competitor.

1.14 Safety

All pertinent firearms safety practices will be observed. Failure to follow safety rules or direction from Range Officers or Range Jury may be cause for disqualification and/or removal.

Eye protection is recommended for all competitors and officials on ranges while shooting is in progress. Any medical emergencies should be immediately reported to a range official.

The Organizing Committee and the Shooting Federation of Canada will not be responsible for any articles lost or stolen or any article left at the range during the competition.

No uncased rifle or pistol firearms or air guns may be transported outside of the shooting range.

1.15 Air Rifle/Pistol Propellant

Compressed air will be available for filling rifle and pistol cylinders, but competitors must provide their own tank/cylinder adapters. If you require CO2 gas, you must provide your own.

1.16 Smoking/Vaping/Cannabis and/or Substance Use

Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted in any range, stats or scoring offices, any other closed room or tent, OR on any of the firing lines. Kindly go beyond the parking lot area and away from the on-site propane tank if you must smoke or vape.

Alcoholic beverages, cannabis use of any kind and/or any illegal substance use is not permitted on the premises at all.

1.17 Anti-doping Controls

Anti-doping controls may be conducted by the Shooting Federation of Canada and the Canadian Centre for Drug-free Sport in accordance with ISSF and International Olympic Committee anti-doping regulations.

1.18 Juries and Officials

Specific juries and officials information will be posted on the range(s), as applicable.

1.19 Competition Results

Competition results will be posted on the SFC Website as soon as they are available and sent to all participants by e-mail after the conclusion of the entire event.

1.20 Dress Code

All competitors, officials, coaches, volunteers, and any other parties involved in this event must adhere to the ISSF Dress Code policy as attached hereto as Exhibit I. If this policy is violated in any way, please immediately make a formal report of such breach to the Match Director or the Chief Range Officer.

1.21 Code Of Ethics

All competitors, officials, coaches, volunteers, and any other parties involved in this event must adhere to the ISSF Code of Ethics policy as attached hereto as Exhibit II. If this policy is violated in any way, please immediately make a formal report of such breach to the Match Director or the Chief Range Officer.

Behavior issues: Please be aware that the Organizing Committee will not tolerate any abuse of any kind of our volunteers, officials or competitors. If the organizing committee determines that such abuse has occurred or that the ISSF Code of Ethics has been breached, the organizing committee will eject any individual responsible for such abuse. The individual may be ejected from any venue utilized by the High Performance Team Trials.

1.22 Participant Waiver Form

All participants, whether competitors, coaches, officials, volunteers and/or spectators must sign the appropriate waiver to be in attendance at this event. Please note that minors should sign the Assumption of Risk waiver according to their age only if they are in fact considered under the age of majority in Ontario or their home province or country. Those participants who are Quebec residents must only sign the French version of the appropriate waiver.

All waivers are located at Schedule B and will be provided to sign electronically. No athlete may participate without signing all waiver forms.

ARTICLE 1

PISTOL EVENTS

1.23 Match Information

Rules: Pistol events will be governed by the latest ISSF rules wherever possible unless technical difficulties arise and, in such event, the appropriate notices will be posted prior to the affected event advising of the new rule changes. **The match committee reserves the right to modify the rules, procedures and times dependent upon range conditions and local circumstances.**

Competitor Responsibility: It is the competitor's responsibility to be aware of the rules for competition, to ensure firearms, clothing and equipment are compliant with ISSF specifications before starting the competition, and to inform a range official immediately of any error or deviation from prescribed procedures.

Coaching: These events are individual in nature. While direct coaching is not permitted on the line, nonverbal directions are allowed. Shooters may be assisted by coaches who will be allowed to communicate with them as permitted by the Range Officer. While shooting is in progress, competitors must always advise the Range Officer before leaving the line for any reason.

Equipment: Competitors must provide their own equipment which must comply with ISSF and/or SFC rules, as applicable. Equipment Control is not mandatory but it is recommended you go through in order to ensure all your equipment meets ISSF requirements as spot checks will be conducted on the line. At the completion of each pistol match a random equipment control will take place.

Protests: Filing and deciding of protests will be in accordance with ISSF rules and regulations. The fee is \$25.00 each. The decision of the Jury will be final.

Competitor Numbers: Numbers will be supplied at registration. The competitor number is to be worn on the competitor's back above the waist. Numbers must be visible at all times while competing.

Targets: Megalink targets are used on all positions.

1.24 Squadding

PRACTICE: Practice times will be limited therefore, check the attached schedule closely and any updates that may be posted throughout the event. We may allow additional practice times after the days' events providing we have a Range Officer available.

- a. Squadding will be set initially with each registration.
- b. Changes in squadding may only be approved by the Match Jury. During the Championships, the organizing committee may charge a competitor \$25.00 for relay changes requested, unless an obvious conflict arises. Depending upon conditions, the request may or may not be granted.
- c. A squadding list will be posted prior to the start of the event. This list may change before the match commences, and will be posted at the appropriate results display location as established on each

1.25 Match Disciplines

ALL EVENTS ARE OPEN TO SFC MEMBERS AND VISITORS

25 m Pistol Women: *This competition will be shot under the following conditions at the Saskatoon Wildlife Federation Outdoor Range: There will be a maximum of 15 competitors and is comprised of 1 relay per day of assigned shooting, repeated a second day.*

- 1. *Fired on the 50 m range.*
- 2. ***Megalink electronic scoring will be used.***
- 3. *60 competition shots per competition.*
- 3. *Each competitor will fire **two** complete matches over two days.*
- 4. *Call to the line 13 minutes before start time, 5 minute sighters.*
- 5. *In compliance with rule: 8.7.6.4 sub 5 all competitors will complete the precision stage before the rapid fire stage commences.*
- 6. *Current ISSF rules will apply.*

25 m Rapid Fire: *This competition will be shot under the following conditions at the Saskatoon Wildlife Federation Outdoor Range: There will be 4 competitors per relay over 1 day of assigned shooting with a maximum of 12 total competitors.*

- 1. *Fired on the 50 m range.*
- 2. ***Megalink electronic scoring will be used.***
- 3. *Call to the line 11 minutes before start time, 8 seconds sighting series.*
- 4. *60 competition shots per competition to be completed in two halves of 30 shots per half course. Timing per half course is 8, 6, 4 seconds.*
- 5. *Each competitor will fire **two** complete matches over two days.*
- 6. *Current ISSF rules will apply.*

10 m Air Pistol: *This competition will be shot under the following conditions at the Saskatoon Wildlife Federation Indoor Range: There will be a maximum of 30 competitors per relay and 1 relay per day of assigned shooting.*

1. *Competition takes place on the 10 m range.*
2. ***Megalink electronic targets will be used.***
3. ***Call to the line 20 minutes before start time, 15 minutes sighting and preparation.***
4. *60 competition shots for all competitors.*
5. *Competition is open to male, female and junior competitors.*
6. *Competitors will fire **two** complete matches over two days.*
7. *Sighting shots allowed in the time period assigned.*
8. *Current ISSF rules will apply.*

2.2 Event Summaries

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

ISSF Air Rifle

10 meters standing – shot on electric targets.

All competitors – 2 courses of 60 shots per course.

Air Rifle squadding will be assigned and posted at the range in advance of competition.

Call to the line 20 minutes before start time, 15 minutes sighting and preparation.

ISSF Men 3 Position

Unlimited sighting shots on sighting diagrams.

Shot on electronic targets.

Squadding for relays will be random.

Men and Women 3 Position are fired simultaneously.

2 courses of 20 shots per each of 3 positions = 120

2.3 Registration and Equipment Check

Registration and equipment check will be conducted, on the days and at the times noted in the Schedule of Events (Schedule A). All competitors are strongly urged to register on the days set aside for this purpose due to the tight schedule.

Competitor Numbers - Numbers will be supplied at registration. The competitor number is to be worn on the competitor's back above the waist. Numbers must be visible at all times while competing.

Changing Relays - The assignment of relays for all outdoor events will be carried out so that those competing in the same class will experience similar shooting conditions (time of day, wind, rain, lighting, etc.). Anyone requesting to shoot on a relay other than those on which he/she was originally assigned will not be eligible for awards.

PARTICIPATION WAIVER

This waiver is to be completed by and is only for the use of those participants and spectators who have reached and/or are over the age of majority and should be completed and signed prior to any payment and/or registration or facility entry for this Event.

I am aware that the 2023 High Performance Team Trials – Rifle & Pistol (the “Event”) involves many inherent risks, dangers and hazards, including but not limited to the use and operation of firearms, personal physical injury in association with target shooting as a sport, possible negligence on the part of the event director and organizers, the event hosting venue, event officials and volunteers, coaches, other athletes and spectators.

I, as a participant who has reached and/or is over the age of majority, freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers, and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, property damage, or loss resulting from such dangers, risks, and hazards. In consideration of the Shooting Federation of Canada (SFC) allowing me to take part as manager, coach, volunteer or athlete, official or spectator in this Event, I hereby agree to waive my right to legal action as follows:

1. To assume and accept all risks, dangers and hazards in connection with my participation in, and/or travel to and from the Event;
2.
