1.1 Registration

In order to register you must hold a Shooting Federation of Canada membership and you must be logged in to the website.

Registration and payment must be received by May 24, 2023 or you will not be able to participate.

1.7 SFC Membership

All competitors must be current members of the Shooting Federation of Canada and will be verified by the SFC National Office during registration.

1.8 SFC High Performance Athlete Selection Criteria

To be eligible for the 2024 SFC High Performance Programs you must attend the 2023 High Performance Team Trials and 2023 Canadian National Championships. Please see the SFC website for current information relevant to High Performance Athletes under Selection Criteria [here](#).

Attendance at High Performance Team Trials is mandatory for High Performance Program consideration.

High Performance Team Trials is a qualifying score eligible match only for those not currently on the 2023 High Performance Team. If you would like 2023 High

Performance Team Trials to count as a qualifying score match you must submit a QSDR [form](#) to the High Performance [portal](#) by **May 7, 2023**. On the form you must specify whether the first course of fire, second course of fire, or both will count as a qualifying score. If you do not specify on the form, it will be assumed only the first course of fire will count.

1.9 Major Games Selection

High Performance Team Trials is a selection event for the 2023 Pan Am Games. The best 3 of your 4 scores between High Performance Team Trials and 2023 National Championships will be put into the Pan Am Games Percentage Ranking [List](#) and the top ranked athletes who meet the remainder of the criteria will be selected to the Pan Am Games Team where a quota is available. For full details please consult the Major Games Criteria found [here](#).

High Performance Team Trials is also a selection event for the 2023 World Championships. 2023 High Performance Team athletes will be ranked based on their results at HPTT and will be allowed to attend World Championships in that order.

2024 Pan Am Championships (also known as the 2024 CAT Championships) teams will be selected using 2023 Nationals results only.

1.10 Rules

The 2023 High Performance Team Trials will be conducted according to the current ISSF Rules and Regulation. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

The Jury reserves the right to make exceptions to the Rules as and when necessary. All changes will be announced in writing and posted at the range clubhouse. The Chief Referee (Equipment Control, Classification and Appeals) are designated by the Shotgun Jury to supervise the 2023 High Performance Team Trials and officials will hold a valid ISSF Referee Licence [ISSF A level Shotgun Judge or (2) ISSF Officials /ISSF Referee and/or ISSF B level Shotgun Judge]

The Chief Referee will coordinate with the match director to select an appropriate number of jury members. Selected jury members should be familiar with the ISSF shooting rules and be made up of experienced officials.

The Shotgun Jury will verify with the match director that the targets and equipment used for the competition are in working order and that the targets are set according

to the current ISSF Rules and Regulations.

All competitors are expected to serve as sideline referees. If scheduled to shoot the next round, there will be a 10-minute break between flanking and shooting. If an athlete fails to act as a sideline referee when he/she is required to do so, they shall be penalized as per ISSF Rules. An up-to-date program schedule (with changes to time or added information) will be posted in the clubhouse prior to the match.

1.11 Equipment

All shooting equipment must comply with current ISSF shooting rules. Equipment control will be available to competitors on the day of Pre-Event Training (PET). Mainly to ensure skeet marker tape is compliant with ISSF Rules 9.10.41.42.43

1.12 Targets

White Flyer International Orange Top Targets will be supplied for High Performance program Event.

1.13 Ammunition ordering

Ammunition and target order form can be found in Schedule B. Please contact Bill Stanko (stanko@mymts.net) with a filled out form to place an order.

1.14 Protests

Warning / penalties will be given according to Current ISSF Official Status Rules and Regulations. Protests will be handled by the Jury (Cost \$50.00)

Jury decisions are final.

1.15 Safety

All pertinent firearms safety practices will be observed. Failure to follow safety rules or direction from Range Officers or Range Jury may be cause for disqualification and/or removal.

1.16 Smoking/Vaping/Cannabis and/or Substance Use

Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted in any range, stats or scoring offices, any other closed room or tent, OR on any of the firing lines. Kindly go beyond the parking lot area and away from the on-site propane tank if you must smoke or vape.

Alcoholic beverages, cannabis use of any kind and/or any illegal substance use is not

permitted on the premises at all.

1.17 Anti-doping Controls

Anti-doping controls may be conducted by the Shooting Federation of Canada and the Canadian Centre for Drug-free Sport in accordance with ISSF and International Olympic Committee anti-doping regulations.

1.18 Competition Results

Competition results will be posted on the SFC Website as soon as they are available and sent to all participants by e-mail after the conclusion of the entire event.

1.19 Dress Code

All competitors, officials, coaches, volunteers, and any other parties involved in this event must adhere to the ISSF Dress Code policy as attached hereto as Exhibit I. If this policy is violated in any way, please immediately make a formal report of such breach to the Match Director.

1.20 Code Of Ethics

All competitors, officials, coaches, volunteers, and any other parties involved in this event must adhere to the ISSF Code of Ethics policy as attached hereto as Exhibit II. If this policy is violated in any way, please immediately make a formal report of such breach to the Match Director.

Behavior issues: Please be aware that the Organizing Committee will not tolerate any abuse of any kind of our volunteers, officials or competitors. If the organizing committee determines that such abuse has occurred or that the ISSF Code of Ethics has been breached, the organizing committee will eject any individual responsible for such abuse. The individual may be ejected from any venue utilized by the High Performance Team Trials.

1.21 Participant Waiver Form

All participants, whether competitors, coaches, officials, volunteers must sign the appropriate waiver to be in attendance at this event. Please note that minors should sign the Assumption of Risk waiver according to their age only if they are in fact considered under the age of majority in Manitoba or their home province or country. Those participants who are Quebec residents must only sign the French version of the appropriate waiver.

All waivers are located at Appendix 3 and will be provided to sign electronically. No athlete may participate without signing all waiver forms.

1.22 Competitors Meeting

A Mandatory meeting will be held promptly @ 9:30am on PET Day for both Trap and Skeet in the club house. Rules of the range, athlete flanking, responsibilities and overall information will be provided at this meeting.
