

SHOOTING FEDERATION OF CANADA 2022 HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM CRITERIA – Junior Addendum

COVID-19

The Shooting Federation of Canada is continuing to carefully follow the evolution of the coronavirus on the global and domestic level and how it has impacted the athletes in fulfilling the criteria found within this document. Situations related to the coronavirus pandemic have arisen that may require these criteria to be modified. The HPC reserves the right to modify this criterion as information and situations arise. This may result in short time frames for criteria changes.

All Junior aged athletes are still to follow the 2022 Selection Criteria in full with the exception of the sections listed below:

- Under Section 3 Junior athletes are not required to participate at the 2021 National Championships
- Under Section 3 Junior athletes are still required to submit a QSDR however retroactive scores will be accepted. Athletes do not need to submit the QSDR one month in advance.
- The \$25 fee will be waived for this year only.
- To apply to join the 2022 Junior Team athletes need to submit their scores, a QSDR, and their dateof birth. The name and contact information of the Match Director must also accompany the submission. FOR THIS YEAR ONLY, ISSF JUDGES/REFEREES (as per APPENDIX "A" of the 2022 Athlete Selection Criteria) are NOT required at the competition for the score to be considered.
